






Getting kids back to school

What we've learned as a Nestlé-ICI-TRECC partnership from 131 bridging classes



Bridging classes are an accelerated learning programme to get out-of-school children back into mainstream education.





3482 kids attended



Results



Child-centred approaches helped kids learn fast




99,8% kids completed the classes and re-joined school






Once back in school, most kids stayed





Child labour fell by more than half



A challenging context:

- Results were achieved despite the covid pandemic, which placed additional strain on households and kids and causing child labour to *increase* in many communities.
- Entering formal school can be tough, especially for kids much older than their peers, who faced bullying.
- Teacher turnover in bridging classes was initially high, but increased wages helped retain staff.





Next steps:

- Child-centred teaching methods are being scaled-up through CLEF, a national programme to improve education quality in Côte d'Ivoire. Nestlé has joined many others to support this.
- ICI and Nestlé will continue to provide bridging classes in cocoa communities, as well as other support to help kids get a quality education
- ICI and Nestlé will continue to follow-up and support kids through child labour monitoring & remediation systems
