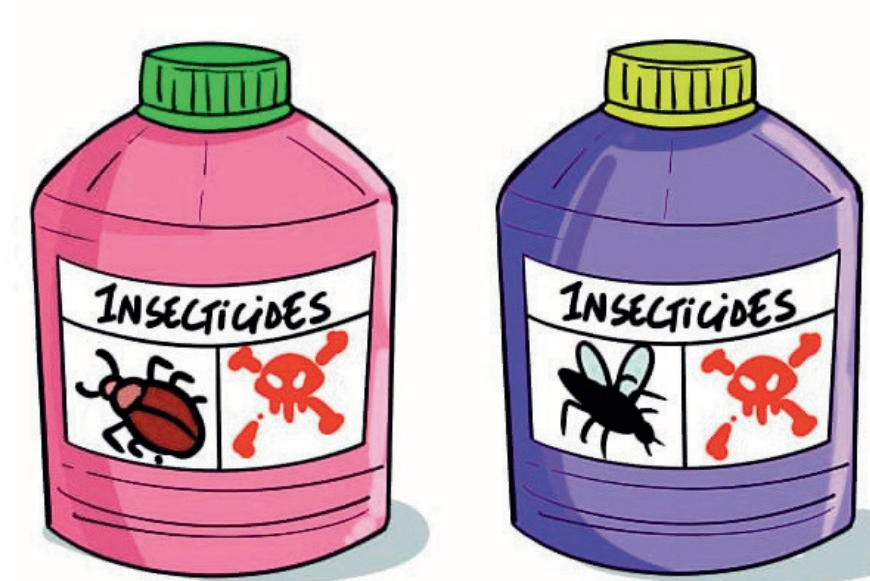


We protect our children from exposure to pesticides

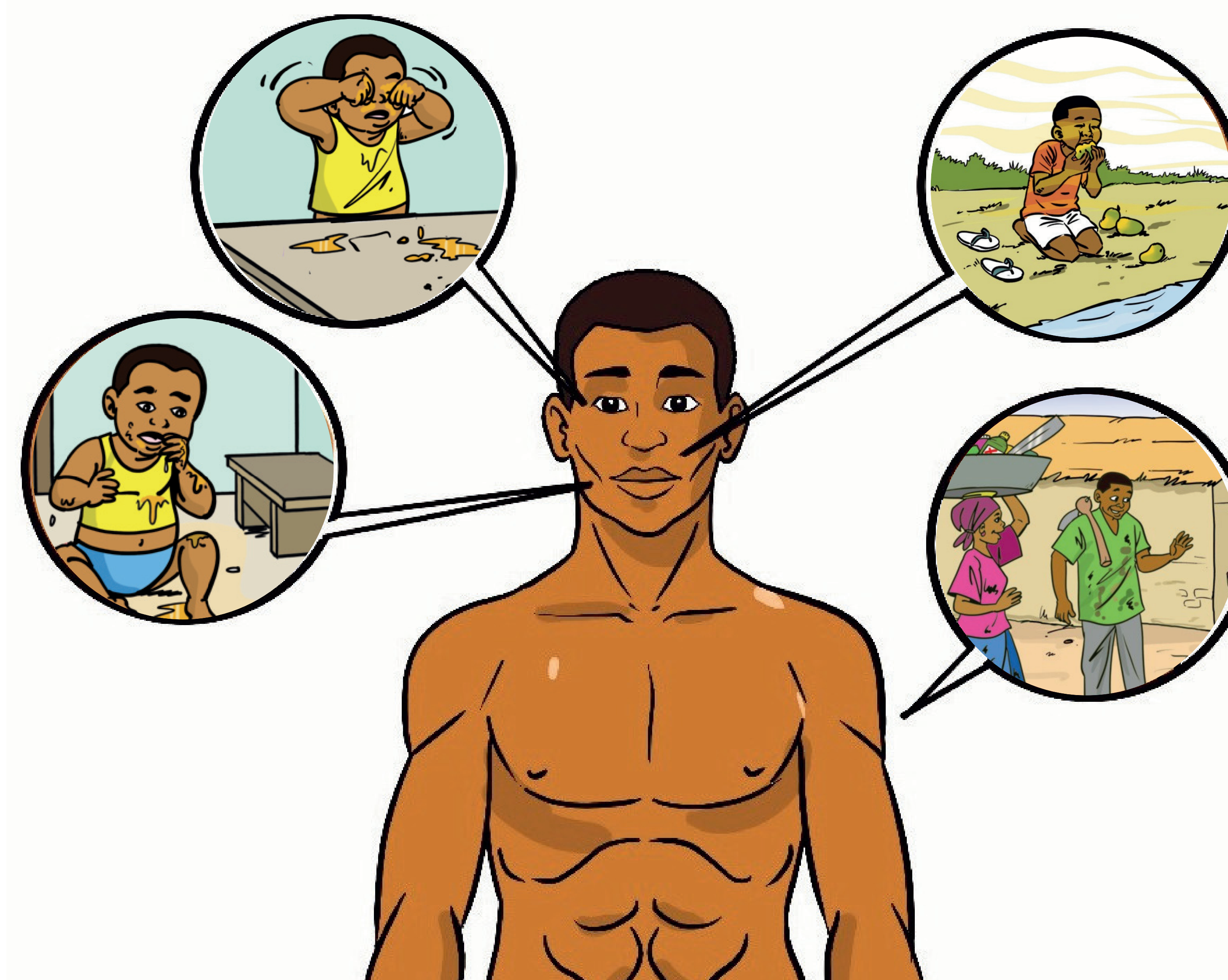

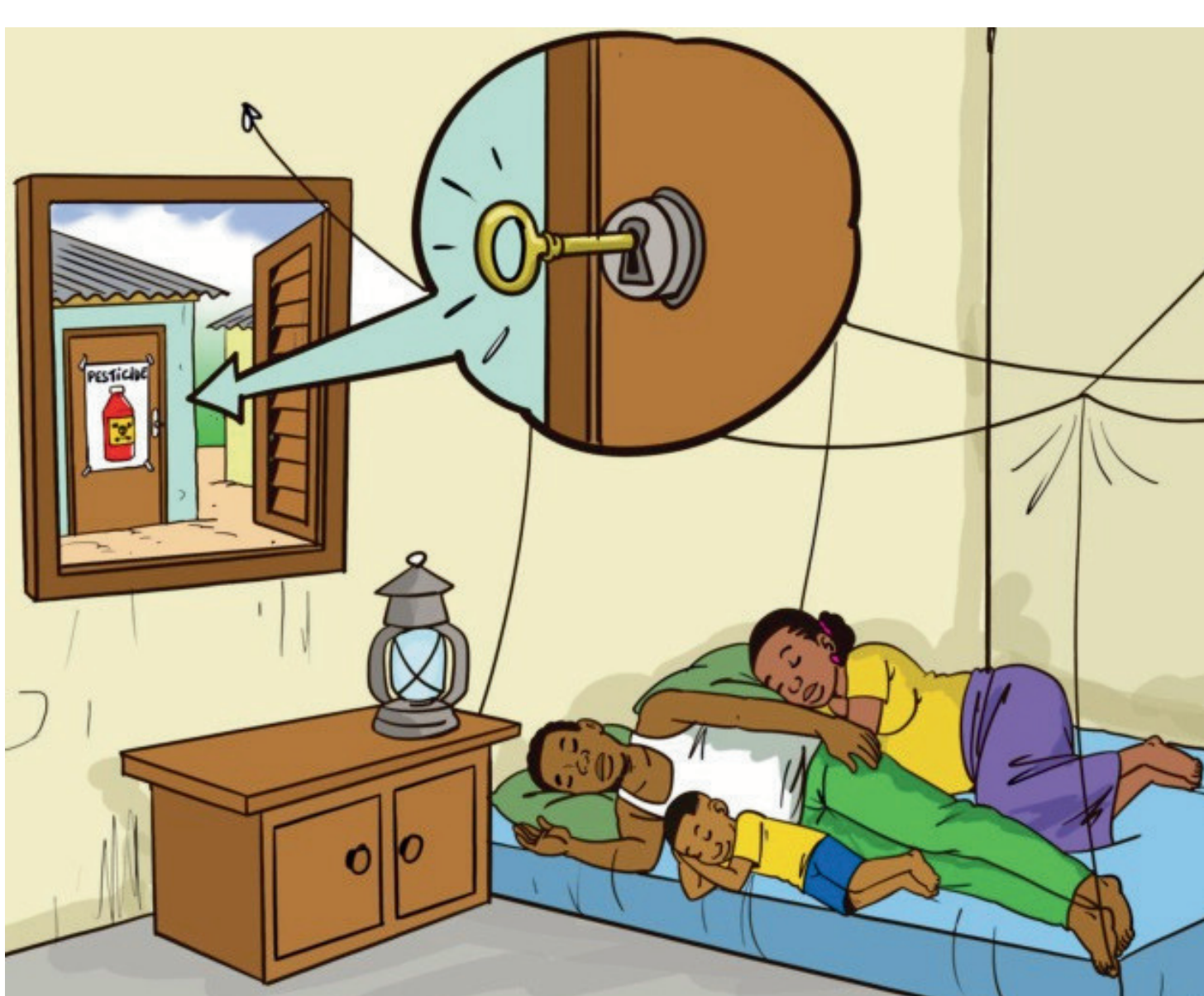

Wash and change your clothes after handling pesticides



Avoid sprayed areas



Wash fruits and vegetables thoroughly before eating



Return the empty pesticide bottles to the cooperative
