A rapid assessment tool to monitor service access and quality in cocoa communities

Questionnaire

This tool has been prepared by ICI to rapidly assess access to services that help protect children in cocoa-growing communities. It captures factors related to children's fundamental rights, such as quality education and safe water, as well as other community characteristics.

- **Bold text** denotes instructions to the enumerator.
- Section A should be filled out **prior to starting the interview**
- Section B should be used to collect information from a **community leader**.
- Section C should be used to collect information from **teachers**.

The following questions are about essential services in this community. But I can only ask these questions if you agree.		
Give a copy of the consent form to the respondent and explains what is written so that the respondent can make an informed decision about whether to participate.

B2	Do most households in this community have access to a protected water source (drinking water)?	Yes = 1 No
B3	Do some households in this community hire adult labourers to do agricultural work?	Yes = 1 No
B4	Has at least one awareness-raising session on child labour taken place in the community in the past year?	Yes = 1 No
B5	Are there any women among the leaders of this community?	Yes = 1 No

B7	Is there at least one primary school in this community?	Yes = 1 No If yes, ask the respondent to show you where the (nearest) school is.

C. Teacher: questions about education

Informed consent

Identify a teacher to answer the questions in this section.

Read this introduction:

C2	Are there separate toilets for boys and girls in the primary school(s) of the community?	Yes = 1 No If yes, ask to see the toilets and confirm through observation.
C3	Do(es) the primary school(s) provide food?	Yes = 1 No
C4	Do some children in the community access scholarships to attend high school?	Yes = 1 No
C5	I am going to read you some statements about discipline at school. For each, tell me if you <i>strongly disagree, disagree, agree, or strongly agree</i> :	
C5.1	“Sometimes teachers have to hit students to make them listen”	Strongly disagree / Disagree / Agree / Strongly agree
C5.2	“Sometimes teachers have to hit students to make them learn”	Strongly disagree / Disagree / Agree / Strongly agree
C5.3	“Sometimes physical punishment is the only way to get students to respect the teacher”	Strongly disagree / Disagree / Agree / Strongly agree

	Repeat question C5 with at least 5 teachers in total, or with all teachers available if there are less than 5. If at least 75% of teachers answer “disagree” or “strongly disagree”, to all questions, score 1 point for question C5.
